The BIG Top says: *What a load of talent! But whether they have a talent to display in a show like that or not, no-one is rubbish – God loves us all whatever we can do.*

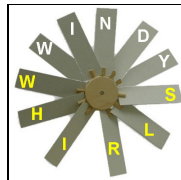
Wastewatchers!

Wastewatcher's Tip of the Day

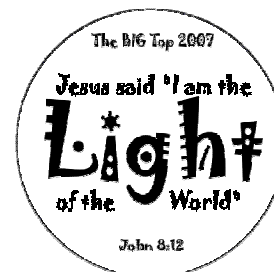
