Mega Maker's Inventors (1)



Tabitha Babbitt
was born in
America in
about 1779. She
was a toolmaker
and inventor.

In 1813, Tabitha was watching two men using an ordinary saw to cut wood. She realised they wasted half their energy because they had to keep on changing direction. She came up with the idea of a circular saw which would go on spinning in one direction.

Craftwork

Today the older children made and decorated cardboard feet. This illustrated their Bible story which was about Jesus asking people to follow him as his disciples.

The younger children also learnt how God made stars, the earth and everything else. For their craft they made suns, moons and stars.

Mega Maker's Inventors (2)



Trevor Baylis lives on Eel Pie Island in Twickenham. In 1991, he saw a tv programme about the

spread of AIDS in Africa. It said that education using radios would help stop the spread of AIDS by giving people the information they needed. But many African homes had no electricity. Before the programme had finished, Trevor had built the first prototype of his best known invention, the clockwork radio. Clockwork radios and other things powered by clockwork are now used in many countries.
