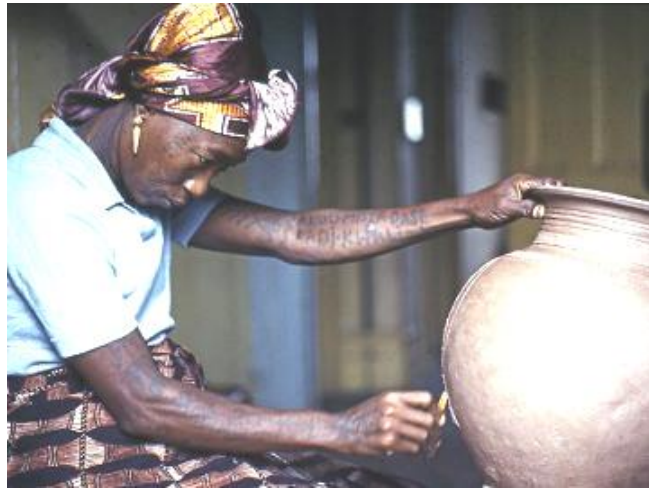

Join our group to see this exhibition and enjoy a companionable day out. **Body Vessel Clay** is the 10th Winter Exhibition to take place at Two Temple Place and this exhibition looks afresh at one of the world's oldest forms of making - ceramics - and its evolution from domestic objects to fine art. It explores work by Black women, beginning in 1950 with the Nigerian potter, Ladi Kwali, through to contemporary makers working today. This beautiful house is one of London's architectural gems, an extraordinary late Victorian mansion built by William Waldorf Astor. It was designed for use as Astor's estate office by the neo-Gothic architect, John Loughborough Pearson and finished in 1895. It is now owned by the Bulldog Trust and supports the charitable activities of the Trust through exhibitions and events hosted in the building. The exhibition runs from 29 Jan – 24 Apr 2022.
